Safety Guidelines

- CPSC (Consumer Product Safety Commission) approved helmets must be worn by all riders. Riders without a helmet will not be permitted to participate on the ride.
- Share the road. Part of the route is on public streets and Michigan law requires you to ride no more than 2 abreast and as near to the right side of the road as possible.
- Obey all stop signs and traffic signs and do not obstruct traffic.
- Headphones are prohibited as they may block out the sound of an approaching vehicle.

Equipment

- A mountain bike or hybrid with tires large enough to handle a variety of surfaces (including loose stone) is highly recommended as part of the trail is not yet surfaced.

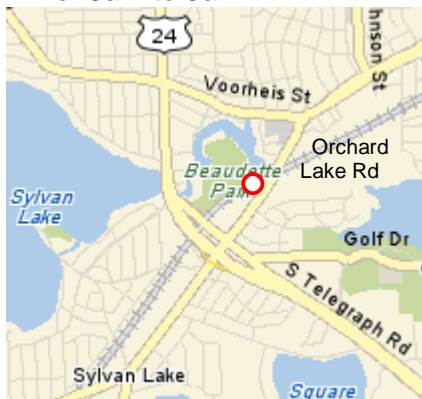

Start Locations:

There are 2 starting locations to avoid crowding on the trail and to allow local riders to bike from their homes. After all, local trails are all about exploring your local environment without the need to drive long distances. Note the staggered start times.

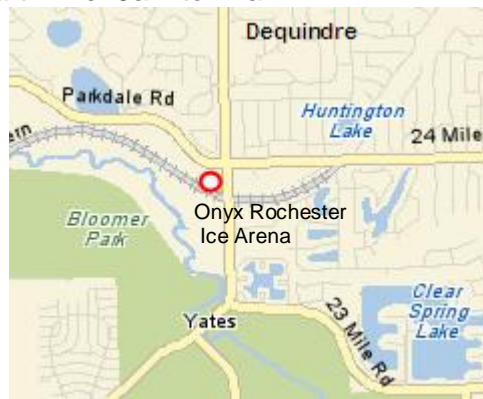
For those that want to start on the west end of the trail - Beaudette Park on Orchard Lake Road east of Telegraph in Pontiac.

Start Time: 8am to 9am



For those that want to start at the east end of the trail - Onyx Rochester Ice Arena at Parkdale and Dequindre.

Start Time: 9am to 11am



The staggered start times allows for all riders to meet up for lunch at Beaudette Park in Pontiac.

Route Description and Sign-in:

The route follows the Clinton River Trail out and back, through the cities of Sylvan Lake, Pontiac, Auburn Hills, Rochester Hills and Rochester. The round trip ride is approx. 25 miles, including the section west of Beaudette Park in Sylvan Lake. A detailed description of the route will be provided in your packet the day of the ride, along with your T-Shirt, lunch ticket and trail map. Riders are required to sign-in and complete a release form and can then proceed at their own pace. T-Shirts are sponsored by Rochester Bike Shop.

Lunch and Rest Stops:

There will be one rest stop with water at approximately the half way point in the City of Auburn Hills.

Lunch will be served between 11:00 and 1:00pm in Beaudette Park and is sponsored by American Cycle & Fitness in Pontiac.
